Drug Administer

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled.

Sec 1 AN ACT TO

To require licensed individuals to administer all prescription drugs.

Sec 2 A - Licensed individual - an individual who has formal permission from my governmental or other constituted authority to do something.

B - Administer - To manage, have charge, or bring into use.

C - Prescription Drugs - A direction written by the physician To a pharmacist to use a certain medication.

Sec 3 This bill will put an end/ lessen the outcome of prescription drug abuse. A caregiver/nurse will be required by this legislation to administer all prescription drugs prescribed to patients in the state of New Mexico. A decrease in prescription drug abuse accident will occur and more jobs will be provided for the betterment of the economy and of society.

Sec 4 All monetary funds necessary for this legislation will come from a 7% tax added to all sales of prescription drugs. All pharmacy's/ Medical facilities must be required to implement this tax and penalties will occur if violation of this tax takes place. If a violation occurs, each facility will be required to pay a \$5,000 fine which will be toward enforcement of this legislation.

Sec 5 If non-complaints of this legislation occurs, a monetary penalty will be enforced in the drug administer. No less than a \$5,000 penalty will occur as a result of this violation.

Sec 6 This legislation will go into effect in January 1, 2019.
