8 Creating a Higher Standard for Magistrate Court Judges in the State of New Mexico

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY NEW

10 MEXICO GIRLS STATE:

11 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. - New Mexico Magistrate court judge: jurisdiction over cases

12 such as landlord-tenant rights, traffic violations, and preliminary felony hearings. Judges

13 also sign off on search and arrest warrants for law enforcement officers.

14 Law Degree: is an academic degree conferred for studies in law. (Juris doctor,

15 Masters of law, Doctor of Juridical Science)

1 Paralegal: a person trained in subsidiary legal matters but not fully qualified as a lawyer

2 SECTION 2. PROVISIONS. - If this bill is passed all candidates for the position of

3 magistrate court judge will be required to have a law degree or 3 years of paralegal

4 experience. If there are absolutely no candidates with law degrees or paralegal experience

5 willing to run for the office, other candidates will be accepted as an alternative candidate in

6 an effort to fill the office.

7 SECTION 3. PENALTY. - If a candidate that does meet the qualifications of the office and

8 is elected they will be stripped of the title and there will be a re-election. This excludes any

9 approved alternative candidates.

10 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION. - There are no appropriations for this bill.

11 All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the Constitution of the State of New

12 Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are hereby repealed.

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14 The provisions of this act shall be effective on and after The provisions of this act shall be

15 effective during the next set of magistrate court judge elections.
