Budget Outline:


Income:

SANITARY ENGINEER – This Official is responsible for the city sanitation facilities, such as sewage, rendering and prohibiting pollution of water and air. At ALA NM Girls State this Official will inspect the City periodically and submit ordinances to the City Council for continuing cleanliness of the City.

Sanitary Engineer Duties

- Advise the ordinance committee on any ordinances pertaining to city cleanliness.
- This individual could help establish shower schedule (if city decides this method) to plan for environmental water impact to the city.
- Periodically check city and dorm meeting rooms for cleanliness and organize cleanups as needed. Cities will be inspected by staff each day with points awarded towards the Outstanding City Competition.
