8 **Expanding Educational Options in High Schools**

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY NEW
11 MEXICO GIRLS STATE:

12 Expanding educational options in highschoools will help decrease the amount of dropouts in
13 both highschool and college. The main reasons highschool students have for dropping out
14 are: Not needing school for their future, school was too boring, or they were failing too
15 many classes. College students tend to drop out because highcshool did not

1 academically prepare them for college or they did not need a degree until later on.

2 Highschool level education needs to be taken serious becayse they are years away
3 from where lives start. Most highschool dropouts end up with unsuccessful life due to most
4 job requirements. Since highschool students dropout because of the lack of interest in the
5 limited educational options, there should be more options in each subject. For example,
6 english classes are limited according to the grade level but, if given the choice of taking a
7 class based on just poetry or the interest of becoming an author in any grade, it would
8 benefit the student on having the proper education for college. Not only would this help
9 highschool students but college students too.

11 With the reason of college dropouts being, highschool not academically preparing them,
12 then expanding options in highschool would benefit them. Previously shown in the second
13 paragraph, taking a class not based on grade levels but on interests and talents will help
14 college students especially in their first year, push to the right direction of their future
15 career. This would result in both highschool and college students taking their education
16 serious and a decrease in dropout.
