Police Chief Report



POLICE CHIEF – This Official is responsible for law enforcement, organization and supervision of the police force, management of the municipal jail, holding violators of ordinances or presenting them for trial, and recommending police measures to the Council. Since all ALA NM Girls State rules are automatically accepted as City ordinances, the Police Chief and Policemen enforce these rules and other City ordinances. They may wish to establish traffic regulations on the City floor. This official also maintains order in meetings of the City Council, Municipal courts and evening gatherings.

Police Chief Report

- ✓ Work with the Ordinance Committee to recommend penalties for city ordinances.
- ✓ Establish a head count process with the Fire Chief to ensure all members of your city are together through emergency drills and meetings.
- Utilize Police force to maintain order during City Meetings and Whistle Stop Campaign

Report Details

As chief of police I communicated with the ordinance committee and implemented penalties to allow our city to stay intact while outsiders enter ^{and when laws are broken}. The penalties established are as followed: sing a cedar chant while being escorted by police officer (noncitizens of cedar), item confiscated by police chief for one night & next day (fire hazards), performing an army crawl to the end of the hallway (campaigning, hanging posters). ~~Other than~~ Other than communicating with the ordinance committee, I spoke to the Fire chief in order to establish head count in case of emergency. The solution we concluded on was assigning each cedar citizen a number, then in order they call out, until we discover that everyone is accounted for. Lastly I spoke with my police officers and appointed them jobs for the upcoming city meetings and whistle stop campaign event. Both officers are aware of their duty in escorting nominees from city to city; because in this city we value the safety of all cedar citizens.

Sanitary Engineer Report



SANITARY ENGINEER – This Official is responsible for the city sanitation facilities, such as sewage, rendering and prohibiting pollution of water and air. At ALA NM Girls State this Official will inspect the City periodically and submit ordinances to the City Council for continuing cleanliness of the City.

Sanitary Engineer Duties

- Advise the ordinance committee on any ordinances pertaining to city cleanliness.
- This individual could help establish shower schedule (if city decides this method) to plan for environmental water impact to the city.
- Periodically check city and dorm meeting rooms for cleanliness and organize cleanups as needed. Cities will be inspected by staff each day with points awarded towards the Outstanding City Competition.

Report Details – List any recommendations, plans or issues as part of duties.

- Shower Schedule: Mornings 5:30 – 6:30 am each citizen will have a limited 3-5 minute shower time. Evenings 9:40 – 11:00 pm same shower time applies to evenings. Every Wednesday showers will be closed in order to conserve more water.
- In order to maintain organization and cleanliness and to prevent clutter I have put attention signs to make sure citizens keep cedar city room clean and organized. Also around the city there are signs about cleanup just to keep an eye on trash around the city
- (first bullet) the shower schedule is put in place to conserve water do to the drought. This schedule will hopefully reduce the usage of water until a plan is figured out till further notice
- Concerning the recent fire extremities I will be putting warning signs about any bonfires they hold to properly put out and clean up. This will help prevent any hazards or any more fires from happening.

HEALTH AND RECREATION OFFICER – The City's water supply, public health, hospitals and medical facilities, park and recreation areas are under the control of this Officer. At ALA NM Girls State this Official will report illness to the nurse and will work with the city counselor on nightly reflection and City recreation. She may even sponsor an exercise program.

Health and Recreation Officer Report

- Work with citizens on overall health and morale. Encouraging participation and establishing a welcome friendly atmosphere in the city.
- Assists city staff presenting nightly reflections.
- Review any provided city snacks and make recommendations for future city snacks.

BUILDING INSPECTOR – Proper and safe facilities for City Government and City citizens are the responsibilities of this Official. At ALA NM Girls State this Official will inspect dormitory rooms, lounge and halls, for neatness and safety.

Building Inspector Report

- Work with Sanitary Engineer to periodically check city and dorm meeting rooms for cleanliness and organize cleanups as needed. Cities will be inspected by staff each day with points awarded toward the Outstanding City Competition
- Review provided supplies and equipment such as easel, campaign material, flyers, etc and make recommendations on any supplies cities should be provided next year.
